

**Tbilisi's third national symposium in critical medicine****Adoption of the Resolution:**

Symposium was held in Tbilisi, 16-20 of November and its title was "New steps in Critical Care Medicine". Symposium was organized by "Ministry of Health, Labour and Social affairs of Georgia", "Georgian Institute of Critical Care Medicine", "Tbilisi state Medical Institute, Critical Care department", "Georgian Academy of Medical Sciences", "Georgian association of Catastrophe and CriticalCare Medicine". Together with Georgian doctors, foreign specialists from USA, Japan, German, France and other countries were working on symposium.

Chairmen of the symposium were Academician of Academy of Medical Sciences of Georgia Zurab Kheladze and Full Professor Zviad Kheladze.

Symposium was transmitted by internet; also some of the reports from USA and Belgium were presented by internet.

Main directions of the symposium were, during global catastrophes finding ways to improve international cooperation. Also there were presented new statements about course of death process and death phenomena. Important place was given to presentations about diagnostics of critical condition and new ways of treatment. Including, studying of stem cell and problems of preparing drugs based on nanotechnology principles.

During symposium plenary session was conducted. Was held editorial board session of journal "Critical Care and Catastrophe Medicine". There was also organized round table," new NATO for 21 century World" participants were Catastrophe and Critical Medicine fields leading specialists from different country.

Symposium set:

To be approved activities of "Georgian Critical Care Medicine Institute", also "Georgian association for Catastrophe and Critical Care Medicine" and journal "Critical Care and Catastrophe medicine" on first, second and third national symposiums middle period. And be recommended to different countries catastrophe and critical care medical services to deeply study those experiences which Georgia got in this direction to incorporate this experiences in different countries similar services. In this respect, attention should be paid to such a new scientific practical directions, presented by Georgian critical care medicine institute, as during limited medical resources "death phenomena", "issues of international cooperation

during global catastrophes”, “management of progenetical precursors processes during critical conditions” and etc.

Considering utmost importance of Georgian Critical Care Medicine Institute’s scientific-practical research in developing different countries Health Care Service development, symposium asks Georgian Government and relevant agencies to provide comprehensive support for above mentioned medical institutions in educational-research and practical field of medicine to provide regular activities.

We request to world’s critical care medicine federation and head of the European society of intensive care medicine to accelerate and positively decide a process of getting catastrophe and critical states medicine’s Georgian association as a national member of this organization.

Note be taken, Tbilisi’s fourth international symposium will be held on 16-21 November, 2012. It will be dedicated to deciding different controversial issues in the field of critical care medicine.
